**MASON CITY** — Community members are invited to join in a wall-raising for Kathy Doeden's Habitat for Humanity home at 9 a.m. today.

The home is under construction at the corner of Eighteenth Street Southwest and Hoover Avenue.

It will be handicapped-accessible to accommodate Doeden's sons Nathan, wheelchair-bound with spina bifida, and Brandon, who has extreme mobility issues due to muscular dystrophy.

The home also will feature highly efficient structurally insulated panels (SIPs).
